- Grade level teams will identify a body of evidence that will collect data to support student growth and achievement in priority and targeted grade level ELA standards.

- Staff will use student data to inform instruction (I.e. small groups). Teachers will monitor student progress and use data sources (including DIBELS, F & P, periodic assessments, culminating events) to evaluate student learning and create a plan for targeted responsive instruction that accelerates, enriches, and extends learning as needed.
- Grade level teams will meet with a reading specialist, resource teacher, staff development teacher, and/or Special area teachers weekly or monthly, with a focus on standardsbased instruction and/or data analysis.
- The leadership team will develop schedules with dedicated time for foundational reading skills, use a fidelity checklist to ensure that open court is implemented effectively and drive professional development as necessary based on the results. To enhance foundational reading skills grades pk-2 will implement a phonemic awareness program daily.
- Grade level teams will create a list of equity-based questions to guide lesson planning (Who is this lesson focused on? Who may be underserved? Who is raising their hands? Etc.)
